

Mountain Amateur Radio Club – Driving Directions

DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE EAST:

Coming to Hiawassee from the East via U.S. 76 (Clayton) or U.S. 75 (Helen), continue all the way through Hiawassee (two traffic lights). On the West side of town, you will cross a short bridge, Georgia Mtn. Fairgrounds will be on your right after the bridge.

Next there is a "T" intersection with a traffic light, Citgo station on the right, GA 288 (Sunnyside Rd.) to the left. Continue West on U.S.76, you'll see a theater marquee on the left, and one end of Jack Dayton Circle - but do NOT turn here, continue on for about a block.

You'll see a small man-made pond on the left and the "other end" of Jack Dayton Circle, IMMEDIATELY past the pond. Also, the entrance to the Ridges Resort and Marina on the right. Turn left onto Jack Dayton Circle. On the left, the first building will be the Chamber of Commerce, then the County's EMS center (emergency vehicles in their parking lot), with our "club house" being the next building.

It is a small, metal, industrial building, antenna tower in the back. You can park in the drive to the building, or in the end of the parking lot for the EMS center, being sure to NOT block any county vehicles.

DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS FROM THE WEST:

If coming from Young Harris, after crossing the mountain just past that town, you'll see a "T" intersection with a traffic light. The road to the left goes to Hayesville. So if coming from Hayesville, you'll turn left at that intersection, toward Hiawassee. If coming from Young Harris, continue straight on U.S. 76 toward Hiawassee.

Within about a mile after the intersection, you'll see the Ridges Resort and Marina on your left. Across from the entrance to the Ridges and on the right, is Jack Dayton Circle. There is a small, man-made pond IMMEDIATELY past Jack Dayton Circle. Turn right onto Jack Dayton Circle.

On the left, the first building will be the Chamber of Commerce, then the County's EMS center (emergency vehicles in their parking lot), with our "club house" being the next building.

It is a small, metal, industrial building, antenna tower in the back. You can park in the drive to the building, or in the end of the parking lot for the EMS center, being sure to NO block any county vehicles.
